Policy: The institution gives scholarships and freeships under the following categories


1. Students poor fund for BPL Students
2. Best Graduate Award
3. Topper of Higher Secondary Final Examination


Process: The institution invites applications for scholarships and freeships by circulating a notice among the students. A valid income certificate from the parents must be provided. After receiving applications from the students, the Students' Poor Fund Committee and the executive committee of the Sonari College Teachers' Unit scrutinize the applications on the basis of merit and the economic condition of the student. The scrutiny committee decides the specific amount for each student as per their needs.

N.B: (1) In the case of the Best Graduate Award, toppers from both streams (arts and science) are recommended for merit scholarships as per the final result of the University.

(2) No student can demand more money in front of the committee.

(3) The committee's decision is final and fixed.
